Kaleidoscope of history unveiled

March of decades and centuries past comes to life



27th March. In 1984, Minsk Tractor Works produced its two millionth tractor.

25th March. In 1905, **Alexander Vecher** was born — a biochemist, poet, academician of the National Academy of Sciences of Belarus and Honoured Figure of Science and Technology of Belarus.

25th March. In 1928, Belarusian writer **Vladimir Mekhov** was born.

25th March. In 1935, Belarusian literary expert **Alexey Ragulya** was born.

26th March. In 1901, **Nikolay Grashchenkov** was born — an academician of the Academy of Sciences of Belarus and an expert in neurology and neurosurgery.

26th March. In 1929, Belarusian heat and mass transfer specialist **Iosif Gurevich** was born.

26th March. In 1940, **Dmitry Zaitsev** was born — a cameraman, film director and Honoured Figure of Arts of Belarus.

27th March. In 1893, conductor and Honoured Figure of Arts of Belarus **Natan Grubin** was born.

27th March. In 1911, **Alexey Spesh-**

nev was born — a Belarusian and Russian screenwriter and film director, and laureate of the State Award of Belarus.

28th March. In 1868, Russian writer and public figure **Maxim Gorky** was born — an honourable academician of the Belarusian Academy of Sciences.

28th March. In 1938, Belarusian choral conductor, folklorist and teacher **Vladimir Rogovich** was born.

29th March. In 1900, Belarusian film director **Vladimir Korsh-Sablin** (Sablin) was born.

29th March. In 1932, Russian and Belarusian producer **Boris Utorov** (Vtorov) was born.

30th March. In 1899, **Sergey Rakovsky** was born — a geologist and gold deposit researcher in Kolyma.



28th March. In 1978, Minsk's Horizont enterprise manufactured its five millionth TV set.

30th March. In 1942, **Victor Ipatiev** was born — a scientist in forestry, pedology and forest radiology.

28th March. In 1921, Belarus' first



professional-technical school of woodworkers solemnly opened.

28th March. In 1958, the Permanent Representative Office of Belarus to the UN was founded.

28th March. In 1917, a brigade of scouts was founded in Minsk.

28th March. In 1989, Minsk-2 International Airport (now Minsk National Airport) welcomed its first passengers.

29th March. In 1931, the Yanka Kupala Literary Institute was founded at the National Academy of Sciences of Belarus.

29th March. In 1960, the Belarusian SSR joined the 1928 Convention on International Exhibitions.

30th March. *Nasha Pravda* (Our Truth) newspaper was launched, published in Vilno (until September 27th, 1927).

31st March. In 1989, the History Museum of the Academy of Sciences of Belarus opened.
