Kaleidoscope of history unveiled

October and November of decades and centuries past come to life

28th October. In 1884, **Florian Zhdanovich** — a theatrical figure, actor and director — was born in Minsk.

29th October. In 1907, **Larisa Alekseeva** was born, a soloist with the State Belarusian Opera and Ballet Theatre of Belarus.

29th October. In 1943, Belarusian writer and literary critic **Vladimir Naumovich** was born in the village of Bavtichi, in the Korelichy District.

30th October. In 1947, People's Artist of Belarus and ballet master **Valentin Yelizariyev** was born.

30th October. In 1905, Belarusian sculptor and People's Artist of the BSSR **Andrey Bembel** was born.

31st October. In 1930, sculptor and Honoured Figure of Arts of Belarus, People's Artist of Belarus **Lev Gumilevsky** was born.

1st November. In 1954, Belarusian poet **Mikhail Shelekhov** was born.

1st November. In 1578, Duke **Dmitry Pozharsky** was born — a military leader and a national hero.

3rd November. In 1882, Belarusian writer and poet **Yakub Kolas** (Konstantin Mitskevich) was born.

28th October. In 1922, the Belarusian State Pedagogical University, named after Maxim Tank, was founded.

28th October. In 1944, Institute of National Economy renewed its activity.

28th October. In 1945, the Pobedy Park was founded near Komsomolskoe

Lake.

28th October. In 1992, Belarus' national football team played its first match.

28th October. In 2002, Belavia Airline launched regular Minsk-Riga-Stockholm-Riga flight.

28th October. In 2003, Minsk hosted 1st Belarusian Space Congress.

30th October. In 1960, the Dashava-Minsk gas pipeline put into operation.

Radziwif, founded Baran (a settlement in the Orsha District consisting of 38 houses). Today, it is located on the River Adrov in the Orsha District.

31st October. In 1968, Arkady Kuleshov and Maxim Tank were named People's Poets of Belarus.

31st October. In 1973, the Palace of Arts opened in Minsk.

30th October. In 1954, the Belarusian State Circus began to be constructed in Minsk.

30th October. In 1921, the Belarusian State University opened its doors, as did its Fundamental Library.

30th October. In 1598, the Hetman of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania, Krzysztof

enterprises operated in Minsk, employing 4,200.

1st November. In 1977, Andrey Makayonok was awarded the title of People's Writer of Belarus.

2nd November. In 1972, the Belarusian Railways' electrified Minsk-Osipovichi section began operation.
